We have come this far and with 3 long years of political experience, and we know we will poll a significant number of votes across each state. In Queensland our vote quite likely to put us contention to win the crucial 6th Senate seat.

For those who are involved in the party but don't follow the political numbers we polled 1.3% of the vote at the last election and this was on the back of little time, zero profile and no money.

The Family First Senator in Victoria polled just 1.8% of primary votes and with preferences won a seat in parliament—so it is all possible if we get the support.

We won't let that happen without a fight and the fight needs to be by all of us.
